- e. If your abstract is accepted, you will be invited to register for the conference. Upon payment of the registration fee, you will be sent a confirmation email receipt.
- f. Your full paper should be written in English with maximum length of 6-8 pages (including tables and figures) on A4 page setup, all margin 2.5 cm, Times New Roman font of 11, space 1, and Reference APA 0.6

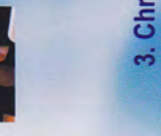
